Austin-Bergstrom International Airport is the 46th largest airport in North America, serving 8.2 million projected total passengers in 2006. The medium hub enjoys 135 departures a day to all major hub airports and a significant number of point to point service.

All major American airlines serve AUS, American, United, Continental, Delta, and Northwest, Aeromexico, plus five low-fare carriers, Southwest Airlines, America West/US Airways, jetBlue Airways, Frontier Airlines and ExpressJet.
